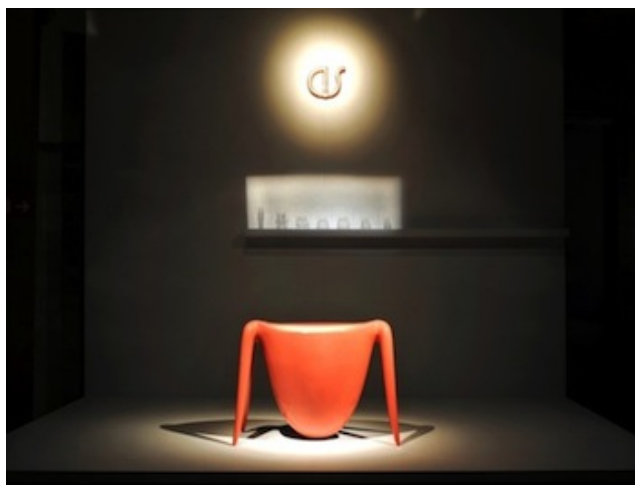




### Stedelijk Museum 's-Hertogenbosch (SM's) acquires extensive jewelry collection by Emmy van Leersum
